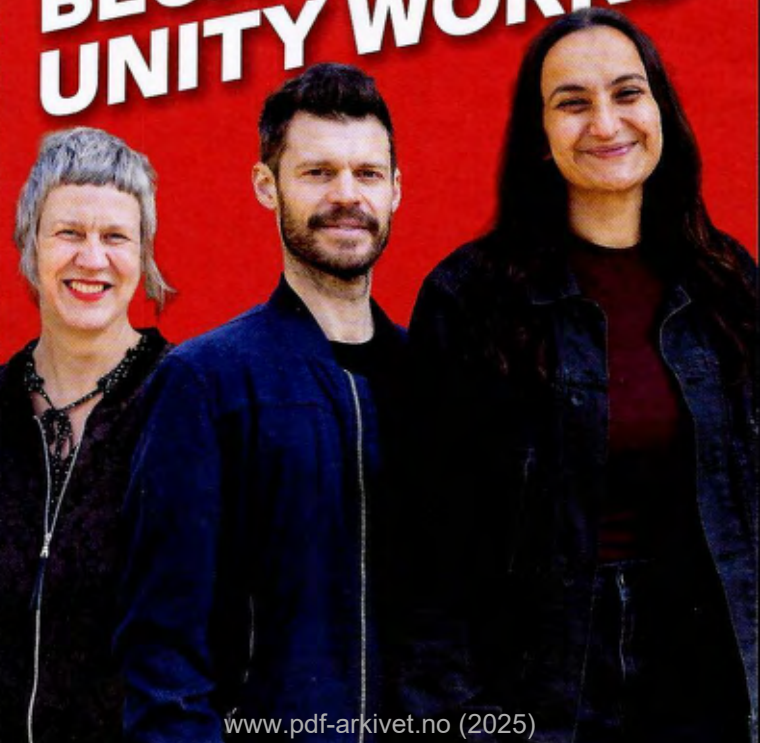

# Fight against inequality in Norway's most class-divided city

Rødt fights for community, welfare, and fair distribution – and against an Oslo with increasing inequality. By standing together, we can reverse the trend.

Every year, cuts are made to the services that many depend on. The city districts receive less and less funding, while their responsibilities grow. All of Oslo is affected when politicians prioritize tax cuts for the wealthy few over shared welfare.

## RØDT WORKS FOR:

- Prioritizing welfare over tax cuts for the wealthy few.
- Increased transfers from the state to Oslo, and from the municipality to the districts.
- Lower taxes on ordinary and low incomes.
- A proper dental health reform, so that dental care doesn't cost more than visiting a regular doctor.

# International solidarity

The fight against increasing inequality, for more rights, more freedom, and more democracy must be international. That is why Rødt stands in solidarity with, among others, Palestine, Kurdistan, and Ukraine.

The Palestinian people is suffering a catastrophic genocide. This is yet another tragic chapter in Israel's long-standing, brutal occupation and oppression of the Palestinian people. Rødt believes that Norway can, and must, do more.

## **RØDT WORKS FOR:**

- Full boycott of Israel. The Oil Fund must withdraw from genocide and occupation.
- Defending and upholding of international law.
- Norway should sign the UN Apartheid Convention.
- Prosecution of those committing genocide and other war crimes.
- Supporting the struggle of democratic movements in countries with authoritarian regimes.

# **A safe working life, a fair pension**

Workers are the ones who generate wealth, and they deserve to keep more of it themselves. It's unfair that owning stocks or inheriting wealth is more profitable than hard work.

Rødt wants to stop day labor and unscrupulous employers who undermine the labor movement and the possibility of permanent employment.

And when you become ill or retire, you shouldn't be doomed to a life below the poverty line, as many are today.

## **RØDT WORKS FOR:**

- Strengthening the right to full, permanent employment. Remove the staffing industry.
- To defend and improve sick leave payments.
- Better staffing in welfare services.
- Increasing pensions and the minimum benefits of the welfare state. Stop raising the retirement age.



# Fair policies for the environment

Capitalism's exploitation of nature and the environment has serious consequences. We must reduce greenhouse gas emissions, pollution, environmental destruction, as well as inequality.

Everyone should be able to live in an environmentally friendly way, and those who pollute and consume the most should bear the largest share of the costs.

## **RØDT WORKS FOR:**

- Better and cheaper public transport under public management. No more tenders!
- Saving the Oslo fjord. The state must contribute to new wastewater treatment plants, and we must limit fishing.
- A ban on new oil exploration.
- All policies must be based on the goal of Norway being a zero-emission society by 2050.
- Using parts of the Oil Fund to invest in environmentally friendly infrastructure and industry.
- Ensuring free access to the coast, preserving Oslo's forests, and maintaining green spaces where people live.
